# Atlanta Public School Jekyll and Cumberland Islands, GA October 19-20, 2017 Trip#11113

Cumberland Island is Georgia's largest and southernmost barrier island. The Island is rich in history, architecture, and natural areas. Where the eastern edge of Cumberland is bounded by the beaches of the Atlantic Ocean, the north, west, and south are bounded by rivers, sounds, and marshes. The marshes are very fertile areas of the ecosystem where much of the food chain begins. Georgia, and especially Cumberland, is blessed with thousands of acres of marshland teeming with wildlife, from tiny organisms to shrimp, fish, and even alligators. The maritime forests, undeveloped beaches and wide marshes have been home to early natives, explorers, and wealthy industrialists. During the tour an environmentalist will lead the group throughout the island providing history and a beach walk to discuss the different species of plants and animals that call the sandy beaches home!

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# Georgia's Barrier Islands (Jekyll and Cumberland Islands) Student Travel Frequently Asked Questions For Parents

## What is included in the cost of the trip?

The cost of the trip includes roundtrip motor coach transportation, 1 night lodging, all tours and admissions, evening activity, 5 meals, Kelly Tours t-shirt, Kelly Tours escort, hotel security, and snacks and drinks along the way.

### What ages can travel?

The student trip to Georgia's barrier islands is open to gifted and talent development students in third grade through twelfth grade. First and second grade students are able to travel with their parent as a chaperone.

## Can I travel with my child?

Parents who choose to travel with their child are considered chaperones. Chaperones are required to submit to a background check & fingerprinting conducted by Atlanta Public Schools at a cost of \$44.25.

### What are the roommate requirements?

Package price is based on quad occupancy. Additional fees will be required for double or triple occupancy. Please reach out to Kelly Tours for more information on pricing.

## How are food restrictions accommodated?

If your child has food restrictions, please indicate so on your medical form as well as reach out to Kelly Tours. Every effort is made by Kelly Tours to accommodate food restrictions, but please be prepared to send alternative food options if you have concerns with the group meals.
